Resolution offered by the Town of Albany in adoption of the Green County All Hazards Mitigation Plan Revision

Resolved by the Town of Albany:

WHEREAS, The Town of Albany recognizes the threat that natural and technological hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions prior to the occurrence of disasters will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Albany participated jointly in the planning process with the other units of government within Green County to prepare an All Hazard Mitigation Plan Revision as an official plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that the Town of Albany hereby adopts the Green County All Hazards Mitigation Plan Revision as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the Green County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the participating municipalities, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan Revision to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.
