

Albany Township Minutes
July 10, 2018

The Town Board met with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting in three places, on the website and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read. A motion by Spangler and seconded by Krupke with an addition that Robb Spangler was absent due to sickness. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$111,025.01 in Checking; \$250,012.92 in Savings; \$81,350.44 in the Building Fund; \$37,600.30 in the Machinery Fund and \$17,536.97 in the Reassessment Fd. State Highway Aids of \$24,320.02 was received. Money will be transferred from Savings to Checking to cover road work bills. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: No one present but questions regarding speed limit change on Stephenson Lane; cleaning a ditch line and changing municipalities.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: The driveway on Bud Lane has been checked. Brian Flannery will continue to monitor it and let Abel know if there is a problem. The first round of mowing has been finished. No spraying done yet.

Building Permits: Three small permits.

Assessor: Open book and Board of Review went well.

Insurance: No report.

Recycling: Dumpsters working well and may need another one.

Other Business: Truck has been ordered. Discussion held on leasing or borrowing part of the money to pay for the truck. Southern Wisconsin sent a pricing agreement for propane. The next regular Board meeting will be Monday, August 13 due to the fall primary election on August 14.
