

Albany Township Minutes
November 13, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, printed and on the website. The minutes were read and approved with the addition that Mary Mason brought the \$5,000.00 check to the Board before the meeting was adjourned.

Treasurer's Report : The Treasurer reported \$191,473.88 in Checking; \$250,119.59 in Savings; \$81,416.12 in the Building Fund; \$37,630.66 in the Machinery Fund; \$17,542.89 in the Reassessment Fund. Town Bank put \$136,169.50 in the checking account as the amount loaned for the truck. The extra \$179.50 was for fees. A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Scott Martin and Alan and Darcy Stephenson were present regarding changing the speed limit on Stephenson Lane. After much discussion a motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Spangler to change the speed limit from 35 mph to 25 mph. Motion carried 2-1.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Ryan and Marcy Brugger were present to get a driveway permit for a new house on Dunphy Rd. Mike Powers was present to get two field driveway permits and a reconstruction of the residential driveway. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the two field driveways and the reconstruction of the residential driveway for Mike Powers. Motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Spangler to approve the Nik Blumer driveway contingent on putting end caps on. Motion carried 3-0. The papers were filled out for the matching fund for next year and the Tin Can 50-50 culvert installation.

Website: Everything ok.

Plan Commission: No report.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Kara Blue, librarian, will be leaving December 8. Spangler will meet with her for the transition.

Recycling: There was a bid on a grapple bucket. Nothing is final at this time. A meeting will be held next week. The Board wants to have an itemized bill for the cost of the recycling amount.

Other Business: It was decided to put a For Sale sign on the old truck and set it out to see if anyone is interested. The Budget Hearing to approve the 2019 budget will be November 28 at 6:30 p.m. The next regular meeting will be December 11. The Clerk and Treasurer will be attending the Fall meeting for Clerks and Treasurer's at the Court House tomorrow.

Payment of Bills: The bills were presented: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
