

Albany Township Minutes  
December 11, 2018

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, on the website and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read approved with one correction – the vote on Stephenson Lane was 2-1.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$163,322.81 in Checking; \$250,150.42 in Savings; \$81,432.85 in the Building Fund; \$37,638.40 in the Machinery Fund and \$17,544.34 in the Reassessment Fund. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: No report.

Website: A new website provider will be needed as Wayne Stemple recently passed away.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to refund the driveway permit money to Mike Powers on the successful completion of his driveways. Motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to refund the driveway permit money to Nicholas Blumer based on the successful completion of his driveway. Motion carried 3-0. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to refund the driveway permit money to Taylor Hillard on the successful completion of his driveway. Motion carried 3-0. Seven loads of salt and 2 loads of chips will be delivered soon.

Building Inspector: No permits this time.

Assessor: A new contract is due. A motion by Spangler and seconded by Schultz to sign the 3 year assessment contract as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Insurance: The Rural Insurance bill is due January 1, 2019.

Library: A new library director is needed. SCLS is posting ads for a new director. Deadline for applying is January 11.

Recycling: A group of Village Board members was present to discuss the Recycling Center bill. A bill was presented with income and expenses listed. It was what the Board was asking for. After the discussion the Board will send a check for \$19,681.64 for the 2017 billing. The Board appreciates them showing us the way the bill was arrived at.

Other Business: The Fire Department is wanting to move a water line and some other things that are needed. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve moving the water line at

the Fire Department's discretion per their request. Motion carried 3-0. The next regular Board meeting will be January 8.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Krupke and seconded by Spangler to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
