

Albany Township Minutes
April 16, 2019

The Town Board met at the Town Hall following the Annual Meeting. Proof of posting verified in three places. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. The oath of office was given to Abel Schultz, Chairman; Douglas Lawrence, 1st Supervisor; Scott Roth, 2nd Supervisor; Grace Spangler, Treasurer and Bonnie Zee, Clerk prior to the Annual Meeting.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$75,185.51 in Checking; \$270,284.99 in Savings; \$84,003.25 in the Building Fund; \$45,175.22 in the Machinery Fund and \$20,050.93 in the Reassessment Fund. State Highway Aids of \$24,302.02 were received. At this time no funds will be transferred to Savings. She also noted that the Clerk received a check from the Wisconsin Disaster Fund for 2018 work done on Decatur- Albany Rd. caused by flooding. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Jamie Stephenson from the Albany EMS was present to let the Board know that the First Response team was suspended for thirty days starting April 1. There are plans in place with other municipalities for mutual aid if needed.

Website: JJ Sterr gave a proposal for the new website. After discussion a motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to have JJ Sterr as the webmaster. Motion carried 3-0.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the request for a driveway permit to Orland Koppes, 5735 Francis Circle. Motion carried 3-0. A check for \$1,000.00 was given for the permit.

Discussion held on road work for 2019. The Board members along with Ron Krupke will check the roads and decide which ones to do for the coming year. Emanuel Estates road was discussed. The residents would need to do .7 mile of seal coating, etc.

Building Inspector: One permit was given out in March.

Assessor: There is no date for the Open Book and Board of Review yet.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Scott Roth will be the Board representative on the Library Board. The Library recently had a Teacher's Tea, voted to reappoint Angela Janes as the Township representative and have done some computer upgrades.

Recycling: Doug Lawrence and Abel Schultz will be on the Joint Recycling Board. The contract between Village and Township needs to be redone. We have a credit at the Green County Waste Management landfill.

Other Business: Roth wondered if we have a plan in place for major equipment needs in the next few years. Nothing set up at this time. The next meeting will be May 14.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
