

Albany Township Minutes
May 14, 2019

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting in three places, published, and on the website. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$89,414.89 in Checking; \$270,318.31 in Savings; \$84,019.52 in the Building Fund; \$45,184.51 in the Machinery Fund; and \$20,052.58 in the Reassessment Fund. Deposits were from Wisconsin Disaster Fund; refund for Tin Can culvert repair, DNR, and Lottery Credit. Discussion held on putting money in the funds. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to put \$2500.00 in the Reassessment Fund, \$10,000.00 in the Machinery Fund and nothing in the Building Fund at this time. Motion carried 3-0. Discussion was held on having an e-mail address other than our personal address. A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Scott for each Board member to have a separate e-mail for Board business. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: No new driveway permits this month. Discussion held on Chapter 90 law regarding fence viewing. The County Highway Commission will do an estimate of cost of 1 mile east on Dunphy Rd. from 104. TRIP refund from 2018 on Dunphy Rd is \$15,000.00 and will be received after our engineer approves the work. 2019 road projects are not finalized yet. Future TRIP funds have been approved for Purinton Rd. We have 5 years to do the work and can change the road project to another road one time if necessary.

Building Inspector: There were three house permits and several smaller permits.

Assessor: No time has been set yet for the open book and board of review.

Insurance: There was a \$163.00 refund on workman's comp. Also, a bill paid for the yearly audit.

Library: Roth attended the May 7 meeting. The new director is working with the school regarding what is available. Things are going well. Another part time person may be hired.

Recycling: No meeting. Discussion held on redoing the joint contract with the Village.

Other Business: The next regular meeting will be June 11.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
