

Albany Township Minutes  
January 8, 2019

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places and published. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$547,467.61 in Checking; \$270,185.05 in Savings; \$83,950.47 in the Building Fund; \$45,147.37 in the Machinery Fund and \$20,044.34 in the Reassessment Fund. Tax collections of \$627,175.61 were received from the Green County Treasurer to be disbursed to the schools and the County. State Highway aids were also received for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Website: Looking for a new webmaster.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Krupke has been cutting brush. Discussion held on renting a wood chipper from the County or buying one. Ron will check with the County first. A driveway has been requested for a parcel at the Kittleson farm on Highway X. It will need to be given out by the County. Carl Schlapbach asked about having a ditch from his driveway to the corner of Tin Can Rd and Highway F to keep the water out of his fields.

Building Inspector: One permit for the past month.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: Audit report due early February.

Library: They will be interviewing for a new director soon.

Recycling: No meeting held.

Other Business: The old truck was sold today. The new truck is at the Town Hall. Caucus will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 12. The next regular meeting will be February 12.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Spangler and seconded by Krupke to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
