

Albany Township Minutes
August 13, 2019

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting published, on the website and posted.

Approval of July minutes: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to approve the July minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: the Treasurer reported \$57,715.79 in the Checking; \$270,416.97 in Savings; \$84,972.48 in the Building Fund; \$55,214.03 in the Machinery Fund, and \$22,557.75 in the Reassessment Fund. Fire dues of \$4,448.15 were received. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Lawrence to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Ben Varesi was present to have the Board sign a paper to take to Green County Zoning for a conditional use permit. A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to approve the signing of the Town Review of County Application Requiring a Public Hearing form. Motion carried 3-0.

Website: Discussion was held on putting links to the library on the site. Also, we will be getting some frequently asked questions put on in the future.

Plan Commission: No report.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Todd Kittelsen was present to apply for a driveway permit. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve the driveway permit for Todd and Diana Kttelsen. Motion carried 3-0.

Discussion held regarding end walls on driveways. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence that all new driveways have metal end walls a minimum of 18" in diameter installed and the driveway at least 30'. Motion carried 3-0. Brooklyn Township blacktopped Brooklyn-Albany Rd. last year and seal coated this year. The snow plowing arrangement with Brooklyn Township will remain the same as before. Mowers ok. Some fire numbers are fading. The Green County website has information on fire numbers.

Building Inspector: Two permits.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No report.

Library: There is good outreach to the school. Things are going well.

Recycling: No meeting. Ron priced new tires for the skid steer at Abamy Tire. Schlapbach's do not have a problem with brush being brought to the pit whole.

Fire and Ambulance Report. Lawrence has been going to the meetings. He is not a voting member. We do get minutes from them.

Building Security: The building is locked during the day now.

Cemetery: The 1977 minutes confirmed that the matter of Norwegian Cemetery was taken care.

Other Business: Information was received from the Towns Association regarding deputy clerk. We will not be getting Wi-Fi at the present time. A business on Hwy 59 will be getting a conditional use permit in the near future. The next regular meeting will be September 10.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
