

Albany Township Minutes
December 10, 2019

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified . The November minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$33,471.42 in Checking; \$210,473.86 in Savings; \$84,142.77 in the Building Fund; \$55,260.20 in the Machinery Fund; and \$22,565.31 in the Reassessment Fund. A sub-grant of \$1,100.00 from State of WI Elections was received. A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: It was agreed to take of the advertisement for snow plow driver and deputy clerk. The old website is still on. It should be going off sometime in January.

Plan Commission: Monya Dujardin and Hasse Surveying were present regarding the ALFARM acreage. There will be two lots. There is a buyer for Lot 1 now. This needs to go to Green County for approval. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Roth to approve the recertification of the ALFARM acreage on Brooklyn-Albany Rd. Motion carried 3-0. There are some things on the Sugar River Crossing plat that need to be taken care of.

Roads and Driveway Permits: There were no new driveway permits. Tin Can Rd was signed up for the 90-10 program. This can be worked on over six years. Discussion held on buying a multi-use dump trailer big enough to haul the skid steer. It was tabled until the January meeting.

Building Inspector: There were two small permits and a house permit.

Assessor: Linda Gardiner gave us information on things that do not need to be kept and some that need to be kept for five years. The assessment rolls need to be kept indefinitely.

Insurance: The yearly policy was reviewed and payment will be due January 1,2020.

Library: The Snack with Santa went well.

Recycling: No report.

Other Business: Lawrence talked to Office Pro in Janesville regarding tables, etc. They will give us an estimate of things that we need.

Computer Update: We will be looking to get a laptop computer that will be used for the Wisconsin Elections work.

Election workers appointed for the next year are Holly Atkinson, Karla Neild, Suzette Sherman, and Laura Roth. The next regular meeting will be Monday, January 13, 2020.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
