

Albany Township Minutes
May 12, 2020

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website.

Approval of April minutes: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Scott to approve the April minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$126,546.23 in Checking; \$210,506.97 in Savings; \$84,230.44 in the Building Fund; \$65,326.42 in the Machinery Fund and \$25,074.57 in the Reassessment Fund. DNR money of \$1,448.28 was received. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Public Input: No report.

Website: A question about whether deadlines need to be put on the website. No decision on this.

Plan Commission: Nate and Ashley Miller's plan was not approved as yet.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Bump Rd and Wild Iris Way have been crack sealed and are finished. The total planned for 2020 is \$90,747 which does not include dura patch on Atkinson Rd. or fixing the English Settlement Bridge. Peckham Rd. was repaired by Pinnacle Dairy as a result of manure hauling. A turnaround was made but is too high and lets water stand on the road. The TRIP fund of \$15,000.00 was received. Discussion held on trading work with another Township for spraying, etc. Ron usually works with Mount Pleasant Township. There are two newer houses that the end caps have not been put on yet. There are no new driveway permits on Brooklyn-Albany Rd.

Building Inspector: There was one new home permit and one small permit. Mobile homes are to be put on foundations and not on a slab.

Assessor: The open book and Board of Review have been held up since the Covid-19 problem. Nothing will be done until the legislators decide how to progress.

Insurance: No report.

Library: Their meetings have been on Zoom. The staff has been busy even though the library is closed. Books are now able to be returned and can be ordered and picked up outside of the library. There will be a new Library building sign on the East side of the library visible from Hwy. 59.

Recycling: A meeting will be held on May 18.

Other Business: The new tables and chairs are here -thanks to Doug Lawrence who worked with Office Pro on the purchase. A person interested in the Deputy Clerk position wants information what the duties and pay will be. Spangler will contact him with this information. The next regular meeting will be June 9.

The Board of Review was opened and postponed until June 9.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Lawrence to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Lawrence to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
