

Albany Township Minutes  
September 8, 2020

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting in three places, on the website and published.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the August minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$100,861.25 in Checking; \$210,521.16 in Savings; \$84,289.21 in the Building Fund; \$75,376.04 in the Machinery Fund and \$27,579.10 in the Reassessment Fund. The tax settlement of \$84,607.75 and the WI Cares Sub Grant of \$1,025.00 were noteworthy deposits. Green County Treasurer office is raising the cost of tax collection. After discussing it with her Grace said it would be almost as much to set up a credit card account for taxpayers and a bank collection place as it would for Green County to collect the taxes. It was agreed to continue with the County collecting taxes. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: No Report

Website: It was suggested that the Township telephone number be put on the agenda so that anyone could call in to listen to the meeting. Also on the website to have persons call Green County Zoning for any land split information.

Plan Commission: No meeting held in August.

Roads and Driveway Permits: Scott Pfeuti requested a field driveway permit to widen a driveway on Bump Rd. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the expansion of the current driveway on Bump Rd. Motion carried 3-0. A check for \$500.00 was received from Scott Pfeuti. Ron is starting to mow ditches.

Building Inspector: Several permits and one final permit.

Assessor: Josh Venden purchased land from the Wolfe trust in 2019 and has been trying to see if the land is assessed the same as it was before the purchase. Grace will be helping him get information from the assessor.

Insurance: No report.

Library: They are continuing with limited hours and having Zoom board meetings. They are checking on the cost of solar panels on the roof. A paper to be exempt from the County library tax will be done in October.

Recycling: No meeting last month. Grace has requested four items from the Village Clerk regarding costs, etc. and has not received anything. The Village Clerk was hoping to have it ready for the next Recycling meeting on Sept. 21.

Fire Department: A letter was received from the Village President regarding rumors going around.

Employee Review: The roads are looking good and shoulders are finished. Grace will be working on a basic review form for the next Board meeting.

November Election: There has been a legal problem being able to print the ballots. The County Clerk will print them as soon as possible to be able to get the absentee ballots in the mail by September 17. Envelopes are being labeled and postage put on to be ready to be stuffed with the ballots when they are printed.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
