

Fire Albany Township Minutes  
October 13, 2020

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with 4 members present and one member on phone. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, on the website and published.

Approval of September minutes: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$30,203.64 in Checking; \$210,524.62 in Savings; \$84,299.61 in the Building Fund; \$75,385.34 in the Machinery Fund and \$27,580.24 in the Reassessment Fund. Funds will be transferred from savings to cover checks written this month. The tax collection contract with Green County Treasurer was signed. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: Information on obtaining a fire sign has been added to the website. Discussion held on putting more information on the website for people moving to the Township.

Plan Commission: There were 2 consultations. Discussion was held on the \$300.00 fee for consultations and whether there should be a charge for a consultation. No decision made.

Roads and Driveway Permits: No new driveway permits. The gravel on Peckham Rd. has been taken care of well after the truck traffic this fall. A letter was received from Green Co Highway regarding tree trimming and removal this winter. Labor will be charged but no charge for the machinery.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: No Report.

Library: Donation funds will be used to install solar panels on the roof next spring. A silent auction is going on now. The librarian is requesting an increase of 1% of the budgeted amount from the Village and the Township. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve an increase of \$383.00 for the 2020-2021 budget for a total budget of \$38,733.00. Motion carried 3-0.

Recycling: No meeting held. The Treasurer still has not received information from the Village Clerk regarding charges during the year.

Fire Department: No report. No budget for next year as yet.

Employee Review: The Treasurer put together different forms of employee review. The forms are to be reviewed and are tabled to the November meeting.

November Election: Discussion was held on setting up the Town Hall to accommodate voters for social distancing.

Preliminary Budget Review: Dean is working on setting up budget papers for the coming year.

Other Information: The population estimate is 1141. The next regular meeting will be November 10.

The water fountain needs to be replaced. A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to pay up to \$2,000.00 for the cost of the water fountain and installation. Motion carried 3-0.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
