

Albany Township Minutes
December 8, 2020

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with 4 members present and one member via telephone. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places and on the website.

Approval of November minutes: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the minutes as approved. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$89,835.01 in the Checking account; \$145,5293.94 in the Savings account; \$84,319.28 in the Building Fund; \$75,402.93 in the Machinery Fund and \$27,582.11 in the Reassessment Account. State Shared Revenue was received in November. The Machinery Fund and Reassessment Funds will be added to before the end of the year. A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: Some additional information for new residents was put on the site.

Legal: Robert Duxstad was present to discuss issues the Board had concerns about.

Plan Commission: No meeting for December.

Roads and Driveway Permits: No new driveway permits. Two refunds on finalized driveways were sent out.

Building Inspector: There were two new permits.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: The yearly bill will be paid before the end of the year.

Library: The virtual silent auction went very well. They did not make their goal this year but did have several donations to the library. They will be redoing the roof later on to put solar panels on it. Discussion held on getting a new cleaning service.

Recycling: Nothing received from the Village on expenses and income. Recycling meeting to be held next Monday night.

Fire Department: No report.

Employee Review: The review will be for one year beginning in January. An update of job description is needed and procedures written.

Grapple Bucket and Dump Trailer: Ron Krupke will get prices on these items.

Caucus Date: The Caucus will be held January 12, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Board meeting.

Election workers for the next two years were appointed: They are Karla Neild, Laura Roth and Suzette Sherman. There are two people interested in helping out at the polls also.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.
