

Albany Township Minutes  
January 12, 2021

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present after Caucus was completed. Proof of posting in three places, published and on the website.

Approval of December minutes: A motion was made by Schultz and seconded by Lawrence to approve the December minutes as written. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$1,177,526.24 in Checking; \$145,532.42 in Savings; \$84,319.28 in the Building Fund; \$85,411.30 in the Machinery Fund and \$30,082.82 in the Reassessment Fund. Noteworthy deposits were \$3,801.40 from Routes to Recovery program; and tax collections of \$1,120,334.59. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None

Plan Commission Report. No meeting in December.

Website: Changes have been made and many items entered recently.

Roads and Driveway Permits: No driveway permits were given out. Three loads of salt were delivered last week. Discussion was held on having the County remove trees on Edmunds and possibly Tin can Rd. Clerk to check on the bill for a new culvert put in on Kathy Lobeck farm.

Building Inspector: One small permit. Seals need to be ordered for him.

Assessor: Copies of last year's building permits were sent to Gardiner's office.

Insurance: No report.

Library: The terms of Sue Dunphy and Melissa Everson are expiring soon. The Board approved of renewing their terms and a note will be sent to the Village Clerk regarding this decision.

Recycling: Discussion was held on moving forward with having Township residents bring items to the Town Hall. Many items were discussed and a meeting will be held at 6:30 p.m. on January 26 to work on this project.

Fire Department: Steve Elliott was present to update the Board on pricing out a new fire engine this year. Training and need of more personnel were discussed.

Employee Review: Some changes will be made to the employee review paper.

Grapple Bucket and Dump Trailer: Krupke has been getting prices on trailers. He will look into getting a bucket and then adding a grapple bucket to it.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Schultz to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
