

Albany Township Minutes
February 9, 2021

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting verified in three places, published and on the website.

Approval of January minutes: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Schultz to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$735,693.80 in Checking; \$145,534.89 in Savings; \$84,337.91 in the Building Fund; \$85,420.74 in the Machinery Fund and \$30,083.59 in the Reassessment Fund. Noteworthy deposit was \$582,259.57 from the Green County Treasurer for taxes. A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Lawrence to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: None.

Website: No report.

Plan Commission Report. None.

Roads and Driveway Permits: There were no driveway permits. Krupke and others have been very busy plowing snow and keeping roads in good condition.

Building Inspector: There were two final permits. No paperwork for the previous month.

Assessor: No report.

Insurance: Rural Insurance from our agent would like a listing of the small power tools we own. Krupke will work doing that.

Library: They are still having zoom meetings. There was nothing else to report at this time.

Recycling: There will not be any permits from Green County Zoning on garbage. If a driveway is put in, there may have to be a variance for it. Lawrence has a new price from Badgerland. They will come to a meeting if we want it. Also he will look into gate prices. He will start a spreadsheet on cost of different items. Discussion was held about just having dumpsters brought in. No decision on anything yet. The Board will go to the next Village Board meeting on March 8.

Fire Department: Danny Mueller, Fire Chief, and four firemen were present to give information on their activities and training. There were 87 calls last year. The State Audit was pretty good. They will be training again in water rescue. Also a person will be taking a Safety Officer class and three persons will do the pumper class. Some of these classes are very expensive. Also they are having water issues with

the EMS . Danny suggested we have someone attend the Fire and Police meetings and the EMS meetings.

Employee Review: Tabled to another month.

Grapple Bucket and Dump Trailer. No report.

An agreement between Decatur Township and the Town of Albany was signed regarding road maintenance on Decatur-Albany Rd and Towns Rd. Decatur will take care of plowing and mowing Decatur-Albany Rd. and Albany will do the same on Towns Rd.

Payment of Bills: A motion was made by Roth and seconded by Lawrence to approve the payment of bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjournment: A motion was made by Lawrence and seconded by Roth to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
