

Town of Albany Minutes

April 20, 2021

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. Proof of posting was verified in three places and the website.

Approval of March meeting minutes: A motion was made by Abel Schultz and seconded by Doug Lawrence to approve the minutes as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported \$196,663.05 in Checking, \$145,539.55 in Savings Account, \$84,352.50 in the Building Account, \$85,435.51 in the Machinery Account, and \$30,085.06 in the Reassessment Fund. A motion was made by Doug Lawrence and seconded by Abel Schultz to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. No money was moved from the Checking Account to the Savings Account. Motion carried 3-0.

Website: Nothing was presented.

Plan Commission: Randy Bump reported 1 CSM, 13.47 acres with easement from Wolfe Trust to Brian Beck, was approved. A motion was made by Abel Schultz to approve the CSM on Attica Road for Brian Beck, motion seconded by Scott Roth. Motion carried 3-0.

Roads and Driveway Permits: There were no new Driveway Permits issued. A tree needs to be removed on Edmunds Road. There was a call on a dead deer. DNR says not to move them. Green County does not remove them.

Building Inspector: There were three residential building permits for additions, alterations, and sheds totaling \$171,239.

Assessor: Assessor will bring the assessment book to the Clerk.

Insurance: Nothing was presented.

Library: Solar panels will be installed on the roof.

Recycling: A letter of Termination, regarding the Town's Recycling and Trash Agreement with the Village of Albany, was delivered to the Village Clerk and the Village President. The Village is having a public meeting at the Lions building discussing the possibility of curbside garbage pickup to determine how much interest there is in that. A discussion was held regarding the recycling process to date.

EMS: Kari Briggs resigned as EMS Director and EMS is looking at options to replace her. EMS is considering raising per capita charges.

Fire Department: Nothing was presented.

Employee Review: Employee review will be done in closed session in May's regular meeting.

Grapple Bucket: Tabled any action now, will see what happens with The Town's Recycling Agreement with the Village.

Water Fountain: Schneider Plumbing didn't provide information regarding replacement. It will be replaced in the future.

Payment of Bills: Dean, new Clerk, will go to Greenwoods State Bank to sign a new Signature Card. Checks from Town Bank can be used up to 60 days after the bank buyout on March 26. New checks from Greenwoods State Bank have been ordered. A motion was made by Scott Roth and seconded by Doug Lawrence to pay the bills as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

Bonnie Zee retired after 46 years of service as Town of Albany Clerk. Robb Spangler read a Proclamation as presented by the Wisconsin State Senate. Robb Spangler also read a Proclamation as presented by the US House Representatives and entered into the Congressional Record in Washington DC, proclaiming April 20, 2021 as Bonnie Zee Day. Wendy Detra and Cherie Boss, Bonnie's daughters, gave recollections of Bonnie's 46 years of service for the Town of Albany.

A motion was made by Doug Lawrence and seconded by Scott Roth to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
