

**Town of Albany**  
**Recycling Meeting Minutes**  
June 21, 2021

The Town Board met at the Town Hall with all members present. Karl Blumer (Recycling Center) was also present. The Pledge of Allegiance was shared. Proof of posting was verified in three places, on the website, and published.

Each item on the proposed new Recycling Agreement from the Village of Albany was discussed. The following changes were proposed:

1. Township would pay \$2,500 - \$3,000 for the brush pile clearance.
2. Separate bills for the dumpsters - Township gets billed directly from the waste disposal company.
3. Township prefers not to hold "acceptance days" or pay \$2,000 to the Village per acceptance day.
4. Township wants to get out of owning the skidsteer loader. Ask the Village how they want to do it.
5. Accounting is only needed if the Township shares expenses with the Village. If the Township pays flat fees to the Village, accounting by the Village is not needed.

These changes will be discussed at the Joint Recycling Meeting between the Village and the Township on June 21, 2021.

A motion was made by Scott Roth and seconded by Doug Lawrence to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
