

April 2025 Regular Board Meeting Minute

Called to order: Monday, April 7, 2025, at 6:30 pm at the Town of Albany Town Hall. Proof of Postings: , Town Website.

Motion made by Abel Schultz and 2nd by Doug Lawrence to approve the March 2025 Monthly Board Meeting minutes as presented; all in favor, motion carried.

Public input: 3 residents, Jeff Ortman, Sarah Waidly and Kim Ortman from Wild Iris Way voiced their concerns about the safety issues regarding not having the gravel sweep after chip seal. Motion made by Abel Schultz and 2nd by Scott to have Green County sweep the road. Motioned carried, 2-0 with Doug Lawrence abstaining. Residents requested to be informed of the date of sweeping.

Recognition: A Certificate of Commendation signed by State Senator, Howard Marklein, was presented to Treasurer, Grace Spangler for 13 years of service to the residents of the Town of Albany.

Treasurer's Report: Motion made by Scott Roth and 2nd by Abel Schultz to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. All in favor; motion carried. \$290,000 to be moved from checking to savings to take advantage of higher interest rate. Incoming Treasurer, Amber Krupke, will attend the 025 Continuing Officials Workshop.

Mowing of Township Lawn: Bid from Jeff Letcher = \$65; from DP Concrete = \$85. Ron Krupke to contact Jeff to ensure he has insurance coverage before proceeding with hiring him.

Storm Spotter Classes: No interest.

ARPA Funds Update: Report due 4/30/2025 showing expenditures within the last year submitted. Update to Board will be presented at the May Board Meeting. Suggestions to consume the remaining funds include fire suppression, cameras and locking mechanism for the front gate.

Road Work: Continue to look for part-time snowplow drivers. A. Bump Road Bridge Update – Ron will present at the May Board Meeting. Discussion regarding what roads need to be repaired or replaced took place. Purintun Road trip project must be bid out. Ron to provide details and present his priority list at May Board Meeting.

Skid Loader Purchase: To buy used is approximately \$45,000 plus implements. Recommendation to continue to lease from Ron Krupke at \$50/hour to determine usage before purchasing. 2006 Int'l plow truck needs rebuilding along with cylinder and spinner blade repair or replacement.

Zoning/Building Permits: None.

Planning Commission Report: Sanford Moore land split on Everson Road. Motion by Abel Schultz and 2nd by Scott Roth. All in favor. Motion carried.
